Program Overview

- ½ cent parish wide sales tax
- Commenced April 1, 2019 thru March 31, 2049
- \$1B dollars invested
- Food & medical prescriptions are exempt
- Proceeds can ONLY be spent on APPROVED list of projects

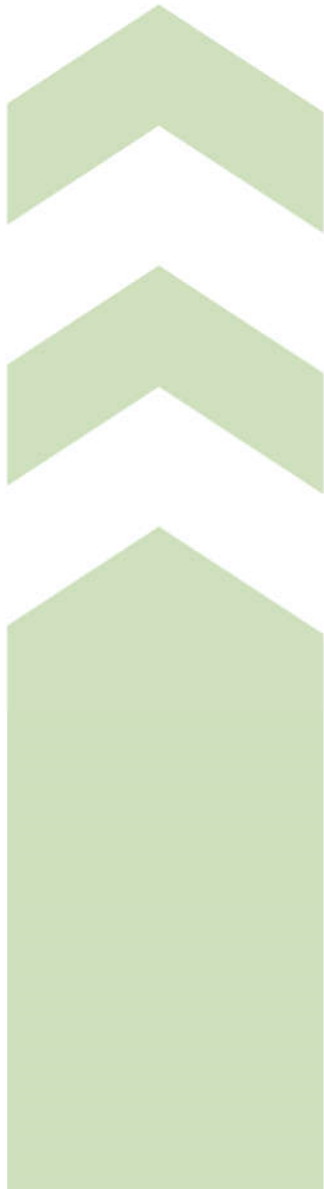
Vision Statement

MOVEBR will be the industry standard of excellence in delivering transportation solutions that will move our region in a safe, sustainable manner and further enhance strong neighborhoods, communities, and economic vitality for all residents of East Baton Rouge

TOTAL	\$921.0 Million	\$1,118.1 Billion

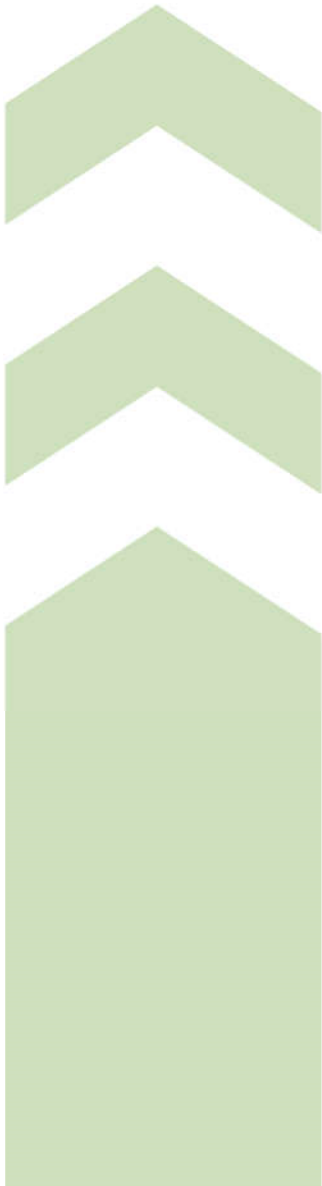

Pending Amendment to Engineering/Surveying Selection Board Ordinance

- Increase threshold from \$50K to \$150K
- Expedites smaller projects
- Reduces workload of Selection Board
