

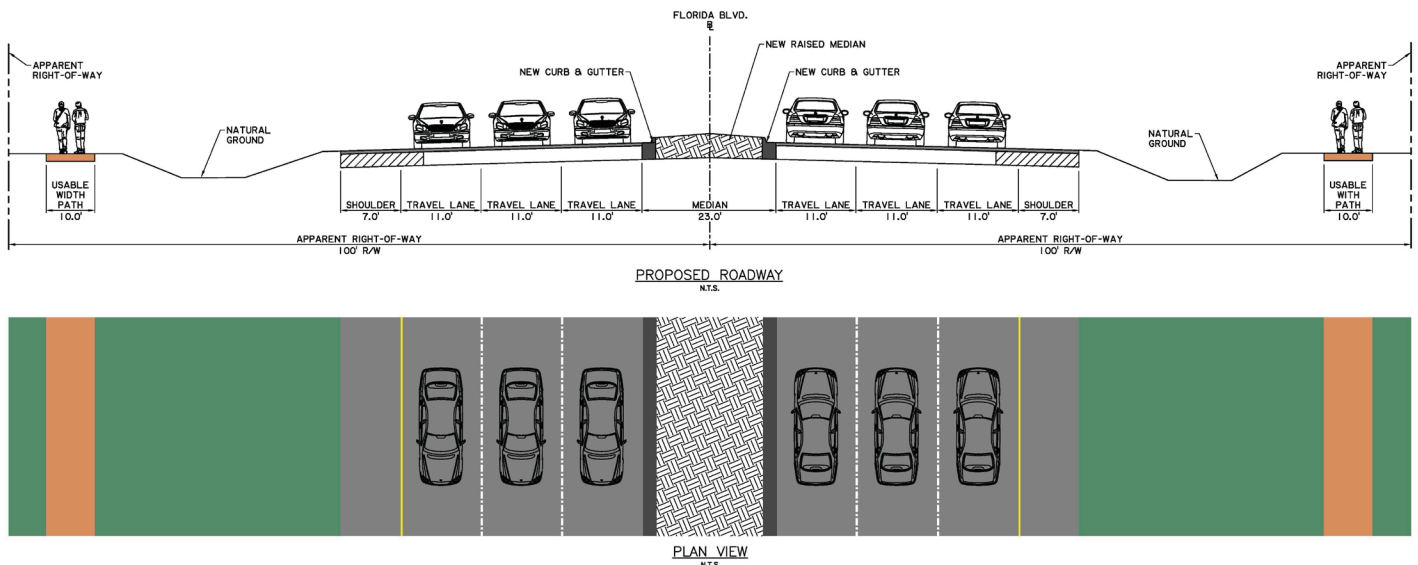


## FLORIDA BOULEVARD CORRIDOR ENHANCEMENT Segment 2 (22nd Street to Airline Highway)

**Project Description:** This project proposes to improve mobility for pedestrians and cyclists through intersection, sidewalk, and signal improvements. The project area extends along three sections of Florida Blvd: the four-lane segment from North 22nd St to Tuscaloosa St, the five-lane segment from Tuscaloosa St to Foster Dr, and the six-lane segment from Foster Dr to Airline Hwy. Safety studies have identified opportunities for improvements that are consistent with LADOTD and EBR Complete Streets policies and are responsive to protection of vulnerable users of the corridor. Improvements to sidewalks in the four- and five-lane sections will provide a continuous pedestrian facility and a 10-foot-wide facility for use by pedestrians and bicyclists that has the potential to connect to existing and/or planned bike routes at Baton Rouge Community College and Melrose Place Subdivision is proposed on each side of the six-lane segment. Three controlled mid-block crossings for pedestrians and cyclists are also proposed, one in each of the three roadway segments. Drainage improvements are proposed from Acadian Thruway to Foster Dr and lighting improvements throughout the corridor will be considered. Consolidation of unused driveways and minimization of excessive pavement will be implemented to improve traffic operations and reduce pedestrian / vehicle conflicts. The project is funded through MOVEBR, a federal INFRA grant awarded to EBR in 2022, and LADOTD program funds.
